Minimum Wage Increase Announced

The government has announced that the adult national minimum wage will increase by 15p an hour, to £6.08, from 1st October 2011.

Other increases are

18-20 year olds - by 6p to £4.98ph

16-17 year olds - by 4p to £3.68ph

apprenticeships by 10p to £2.60ph
